Summer Safety Tips: Water & Boat Safety

Keep your family safe this summer by following these tips from the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).

Water Safety

- Never leave children alone in or near water, even for a moment.
 Close supervision by a responsible adult is the best way to prevent drowning.
- Less experienced swimmers and children under age 5, in or around water, should have an adult preferably one who knows how to swim and perform CPR — within arm's length, providing "touch supervision."
- Never swim alone. Even good swimmers need buddies!
- Drowning can be quick and quiet. You should pay constant attention and not be involved in any other activities while supervising children, even if lifeguards are present.

Boating Safety

- Children should wear life jackets at all times when on boats, docks or near bodies of water.
 Adults should wear life jackets for their own protection, and to set a good example.
- Make sure the life jacket is the right size for your child.
 The jacket should not be loose and should always be worn as instructed with all straps belted.
- Blow-up water wings, toys, rafts and air mattresses should not be used as life jackets or personal flotation devices.
- Adolescents and adults should be warned of the dangers of boating, even as a passenger, when under the influence of alcohol, drugs, and even some prescription medications.
